A post-doctoral position is available at the Laboratory of Hematology of the University of Liege in Belgium. Our laboratory has 2 research lines: one studying multiple myeloma and one focusing on immune aspects of hematopoietic stem cell transplantation. The current project is focused on the identification of novel immunotherapeutic targets in the field of multiple myeloma. This work is based on a proteomic-based identification and stepwise validation of these targets by flow cytometry and immunohistochemistry. For the retained antigens, specific binders will be identified that we will integrate in novel immunotherapeutic tools.
